Southern wall

If you're heading along Moorhouse Ave or Antigua St, you will notice the southern end of the pools building is now being closed in.

This work had been delayed while some subsidence outside of the building was remediated. 80 jet grout columns have been installed to ensure the entire site reacts uniformly in an earthquake.

Around 20 further columns will be installed at a later date to complete this remediation work prior to the building's completion, but enough has been done for now to allow a shift in focus to closing up the building.







Dive platform

The completion of the dive platform pours also allows for the final exterior wall to go on.

The scaffolding is now being removed to reveal the 3m, 5m, 7.5m and 10m platforms.

Landscaping

Staying outside of the building, the area that will be used for the majority of the facility's 550 car parks is taking shape. The entry road from Moorhouse Ave is also becoming increasingly visible.





Fitness space

The glazing in the fitness space that overlooks the leisure pool has now been installed.

Parakiore's fitness area is made up of a 350m2 fitness centre (photo), 110m2 spin studio and 200m2 mind body room for Pilates and yoga.







MOVE Centre

On level two is the Move Centre, where the 12metre-high gantries have been installed in the ciro-arts studio and the wall linings are going on in the dry diving space.

Sports House

Also on level two is Sports House, which has office space for around 90 people. This will be home for Sport Canterbury, other sports administrators and Council staff. Work to install the ceiling is currently underway in this space.
